CARLSBAD, Calif. – June 25, 2015 – GIA's museum in Carlsbad, CA will celebrate 25 years of jewelry design with a finely curated selection of nearly 200 works of jewelry and objet d'art by 40 members of the American Jewelry Design Council (AJDC) beginning July 29. "Variations on a Theme: 25 Years of Design from the AJDC" is a dramatic, thought-provoking and entertaining display that challenges and inspires visitors to consider thematic elements expressed in design. Jewelry designers' exhibit opens Wed. at GIA

CARLSBAD — An exhibit of jewelry and objet d'art by several dozen of the country's top jewelry designers opens July 29 at the museum of the Gemological Institute of America based in Carlsbad.

The show features 200 works by 40 members of the American Jewelry Design Council, aka AJDC, a nonprofit that raises awareness about American jewelry design and the aesthetic value of artistic fine jewelry.

The display, entitled, "Variations on a Theme: 25 Years of Design from the AJDC" presents thought-provoking pieces with dramatic and sometimes entertaining elements.

The exhibit is part of a design project that began in 1996. Each year designers have been challenged to create works based on a common theme, such as water, puzzle, tear and flight.

"The result is an array of designs with a common thread, each distinctly expressive of its designer, that elevates American jewelry designs as works of art sought by collectors and museums," said Kristin Mahan, a GIA spokeswoman.

This exhibit debuted two years ago at the Forbes Galleries in New York and will be on view at the nonprofit institute through next June.

The Institute's museum is free and open to the public on weekdays by reservation.

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

The American Jewelry Design Council (AJDC) will celebrate 25 years of jewelry design at GIA's museum in Carlsbad, CA beginning July 29. "Variations on a Theme: 25 Years of Design from the AJDC" is a dramatic, thought-provoking and entertaining display that challenges and inspires visitors to consider thematic elements expressed in design. The exhibit will be on view through June 2016. "Variations on a Theme" is a traveling exhibition of nearly 200 pieces created by 40 AJDC designers as part of an annual project started in 1996. Each year the one- or two-word themes -such as spiral, fire, rhythm and black & white - offer designers the opportunity to interpret meaning from their individual perspective. The result is an array of designs with a common thread, each markedly expressive of its designer, that elevates America jewelry designs as works of art sought by collectors and museums. The AJDC is a nonprofit education group formed in 1998 to promote American jewelry design and is dedicated to raising awareness about the aesthetic artistic value of fine jewelry. This exhibit, which celebrates 25 years of AJDC, debuted in September 2013 at the Forbes Galleries in New York, followed by an exhibit at Kent State University in Ohio. "Variations on a Theme" will be on display in Carlsbad from July 29 through June 2016.
